- 0900 Hrs      **Stansbury Award winning foreshore Markets Stansbury.**  
Foreshore display of classic boats, classic cars and motorbikes from local areas and further afield,  
Stansbury Primary School coffee & cake stall.  
Blacksmiths display & sales.  
Stationary engines & machinery display  
**Large collection of vintage caravans on display inside the foreshore caravan park**
- 0930 Hrs      **Navy Band** playing live music throughout the day.
- 1000 Hrs      Arrival of a cavalcade of Hot Rods.

- 1400 Hrs      All vessels assemble in the designated area.

# Program of events and activities

## Sunday 14 April 2024 at Port Vincent

Brindabella and The One and All arriving Saturday afternoon.  
(anchored in the bay overnight )

- 0830 Hrs Marina open to the public for viewing of boats.
- 0900 Hrs Foreshore display of classic cars and motor bikes, Hot Rods, vintage caravans, stationary engines and Blacksmiths.  
**Institute** opens 9 am to 4pm with display of Mission X story banners from the Australian Maritime Museum, display of the construction of wooden boats and other maritime connected displays.  
**Art display**, Marine themed artworks
- 0930 Hrs **Navy Band** playing live music at the wharf area throughout the day.  
**Model boats**, both sail and power on water display.  
Food stalls and Watsacowie Brewing Co.
- 1000 Hrs Human powered boats move to the beach area south of the wharf, various on water activities including kayaks etc.  
On water display of speed boats.  
Rowing demonstration by the St Ayles Skiffs.
- 1030 Hrs Entrants to receive the” **Blessing of the fleet**” as they depart the marina. Piper to accompany the Blessing. Boats will be escorted around the ‘One and All ‘ and Brindabella before assembling in the bay.
- 1200 Hrs On water demonstration at the wharf, kayak Eskimo rolls, capsize and righting dinghies, retrieval demonstration.
- 1300 Hrs **Grand Parade of boats** to proceed in the main channel to pass in front of the wharf and then passing back out the channel while smaller boats head to the beach area for viewing.
