## Saturday 13 April 2024 Stansbury

- 9.00 am **Award winning Stansbury Seaside Markets.** Arts, crafts, local produce, and entertainment.  
**Stansbury foreshore displays** of classic boats, cars and motor bikes from local areas and further afield, vintage caravans, stationary engines, old machinery and tractors in association with
- 9.30am **Navy Band playing live music.**
- 10.00am **Arrival of a cavalcade of Hot Rods.**  
**Model boats display** on Stansbury foreshore.
- 11.30am **Launch of human powered craft** at Stansbury Boat Ramp.
- 12.30pm **Human powered craft depart** to Port Vincent Marina
- 12.30pm **Launch of remaining classic boats** at Stansbury Boat Ramp.
- 2.00pm **All vessels to assemble in the designated area** (*see chart in the Rally Pack*).  
(approx.) Prior to leaving for Port Vincent, the Flotilla passes along the **south side of the main jetty.**

## Sunday 14 April 2024 at Port Vincent

- 8.00am **Breakfast at Port Vincent Marina** hosted by the Port Vincent Coast Guard. Briefing for boat entrants.
- 8.30am **Marina opens to the public** for viewing of boats.
- 9.00am **Marine Art Exhibition** opens in Port Vincent Institute Supper Room. Art and crafts for sale.  
**"Building Wooden Boats - You can do it too!"** display opens in Port Vincent Institute. Display of classic handcrafted boats and kayaks.  
**S.A. Museum maritime story banners** and other maritime connected displays in Port Vincent Institute main hall.  
**Foreshore displays** of cars and motor bikes, Hot Rods, vintage caravans, and stationary engines.
- 9.30 am **Model boats on display** and on water at Port Vincent Sailing Club.  
**Navy Band Playing live music** at the Port Vincent wharf area.
- 10.00am **Human powered boats** move to the beach area south of the wharf, various on water activities, Dragon Boats, Kayaks etc.  
**Speed Boats** on water display. (TBC)  
**Rowing demonstration** by the St. Ayles Skiffs crews.

- 10.30am **Blessing of the Fleet.** Entrants receive the blessing of the fleet as they depart the Port Vincent Marina. Boats will be escorted to pass around the 'One and All' before assembling in Port Vincent bay.
- 12.00am **On water demonstration** at the Port Vincent wharf, Kayak Eskimo rolls, capsize and righting dinghies, retrieval demonstration.
- 1.00pm **Grand Parade of Boats** to proceed in the main channel to pass in front of the wharf and then passing back out the channel while smaller boats head to the beach area for viewing.
- 2.30pm **Presentation of trophies at Port Vincent.**
